General Information

Leigh Court Farm operates a weekly box scheme We do not run a door-to-door delivery Our customers pick up their orders from various points in Bristol or from the farm itself.

You can choose from the following:

£9.00 veg box with 8 different kinds of vegetables box suitable for 2-3 people.

£17 veg box with a selection of 16 portions of vegetables (including double potatoes and carrots) suitable for a family or 4-5 people.

£12.50 mixed box with 7 veg and 3 fruit items.

£8 fruit bag with 5 – 6 different items.

Any combination of the above maybe ordered regularly, either weekly or fortnightly.

What's in your vegetable box?

Potatoes, carrots and onions will be a staple part of your box the rest is made up with a selection of seasonal vegetables which we try to vary as much as possible on a weekly basis. From June to December the majority of the vegetable box will be grown by Leigh Court Farm.

What's in your fruit bag?

Our fruit bag is £8 and you will receive 5 - 6 different kinds of organically grown fruit, which will always include a 1kg of bananas. We try to source as locally as possible. In season fruit grown at Leigh Court Farm will be included In late winter/early spring we supplement our own vegetables and all of our fruit with high quality organic produce sourced from local growers, and grower's co-operatives in Europe. All the bought in produce is from certified organic sources. No imported produce is air freighted.

Why choose Leigh Court Farm Box scheme?

Leigh Court Farm is the closest grower box scheme to Bristol. We have been expanding the land we farm since 2002, initially at our Portbury site and latterly near Tytnesfield. Which currently amounts to 12 acres under cultivation We think it would be hard to find fresher more local vegetables in Bristol!

Why can't we sell the vegetable boxes as organically grown? We are in the process of converting our land at Tytnesfield to organic production but Soil Association regulations require that land must be farmed organically for at least two years before produce grown on it may be called organic. All our vegetables come from our certified fields, our fields in organic conversion or from other certified organic sources.

How does the scheme work? Boxes may be picked up from the following pick up points every Thursday between 4.30p.m. and 6.30p.m.

Please wait until you have had confirmation from us that you can start the scheme.

Collection Points: Thursday 4.30 – 6.30pm

- **Hope Centre**, Howells.
- **Southville Centre**, Beaulley Road.
- **Toch Easton Community Centre**, Kilburn Street, Easton.
- **Montpellier/Cotham** Gibson Road off Cotham Brow. tel. 01275 375 756 for details of the address.
- **Quartier Vert (85 Whiteladies Road)** go to the rear delivery entrance in Hampton Lane for box pick-up point.
- **The Club Room, Long Ashton Community Centre**

You can pay for your box by cash or cheque. We encourage people to pay for their boxes monthly to minimize administration time, but weekly is fine if that suits your needs better.

What if you forget to collect your box? Boxes not picked up return to the farm and are kept in the packing shed where they may be picked up at any time till Tuesday. There is a map of where we are on the website. You can pay for your box the next Thursday (**You will be asked to pay for boxes not cancelled and not picked up**)

What if you wish to cancel for a week or go on holiday? Please let us know at least 3 days in advance when you want to cancel your box. If you can arrange for a friend to have your box that week it would help us a great deal.

What if you hate beetroot? Or any other particular vegetable. You may nominate up to three ‘dislikes’, which we will substitute with a different vegetable or increase the amount of other items. (This option is not available for the fruit box).

If you have any queries, complaints, compliments or suggestions please let us know. We enjoy meeting and getting feedback from our customers.

If you would like to visit the farm we have regular open days each year for which we advertise before hand.

If you are interested in learning more about organic growing we very much welcome volunteers at any time of the year to help us. We can offer lashings of tea in return!
